Deadline for receipt of all recital related information is April 15, 2012

Notes for teachers:

A flyer with recital details is enclosed for you to share with your students.

Fill out and return the enclosed Recital Registration Form to Maria Delgadillo by 4/15/2012

- Verify that any students participating in the recital are student members of the San Diego Chapter. A roster of the current membership as of March 1, 2012 is enclosed. If a student is not a current member, they should send in a membership application – also included in this packet of information. New students (i.e. students who were not members last year) do not need to pay the late fee.
- Enter the information about the music chosen for each student. Please be considerate of the amount of time needed for all students participating in the recital. If possible, try to restrict the time allotted in the following way: Beginners – 2 minutes; Intermediate – 3 minutes; Advanced – 4 minutes
- Be especially careful with the spelling of students' names and music to be played. Qualifying students will receive trophies and all students will receive a certificate of participation.
- Mark the type of harp needed by each student so that the Chapter can arrange for harps at the recital.

Eligible high school senior students should mail their scholarship application to Maria Delgadillo by April 15, 2012. A copy of the application form is enclosed. Scholarship awards will be announced at the recital.

Make sure students understand that they will not be playing their own harp (and possibly not even their teacher's harp) at the recital. They will be able to warm up on the harps provided at the recital by playing a short portion of their piece starting at 12:30 pm. Harps will be tuned beginning at 1:30 pm and all students should be seated in program order by 1:45 pm.

A recital tradition is for students and teachers to bring cookies or finger food for the reception which follows the recital. Please call Teresa Sumprer at (619) 741-2865 if you plan to volunteer to bring refreshments, usher, or be on the clean-up committee. This is a way for students to give service to our chapter, which is a requirement of eligibility to receive a Senior Scholarship.
